Parish Council Meeting 6th March 7.30 pm at Milton Abbot Village Hall

The following items concerning Chillaton will be considered at this meeting.

Local Plans A further look at the options for developing some kind of local plan for the parish, including not producing one at all.

Housing Needs Survey Following the discussion at the last meeting, to consider using a slightly different survey, covering a broader range of housing need, should one be carried out at all.

Traffic in Chillaton The Traffic Group is working on proposals to put to the village at another open meeting. The Group of course accepts that, ultimately, it is up to local residents as to whether any of their proposals are supported. However, they feel that any ideas they put forward for consideration should be both technically feasible and able to be funded. They are therefore working with the Highway Authority on various design issues and also want to look for sponsorship from local companies to help finance any ideas adopted by the village.

As the Traffic Group is not a legally constituted body, any grant aid provided would have to be paid to the Parish Council and applied by them on our behalf. The Parish Council is therefore being asked to agree to this approach and authorise Chillaton Parish Councillors to approach relevant local companies.

Application for change of use of the ground floor of Preston House [former village shop] to residential use The views of local residents on this application will have been heard by various parish councillors, at the public meeting at Marystow Church on 5th March. The Parish Council will consider what representations it wishes to make to the Borough Council regarding this application.

Repairs to Chillaton Bench Many residents will have noticed that, as part of her tidy up of the adjoining area, Julie Barkwill has renovated the bench seat near the exit from the Square on the road to Lifton. The Parish Council are to be asked to reimburse Julie for the cost of the new wood.
